- Restoration of contacts among family members, through free-of-charge phone calls, transmission of “safe and well” messages, and issue of travel documents to refugees granted resettlement;
- Awareness of International Humanitarian Law (IHL) and psychosocial support to children in need.

PROGRAMME SUMMARY

The programme (with a total budget of €29.7m) aims to provide humanitarian assistance to Syrian refugees and asylum seekers hosted in Jordan with multi-sector aid from the Jordan National Red Crescent Society and the ICRC, through:

- Delivery of food and other essential items, including ready-to-eat meals and other food items, hygienic articles and school kits;
- Provision of health care to the wounded and sick people among them, such as medical screening, primary health care, transfer by ambulance to health facilities, training on emergency-room trauma/mass-casualty management and first aid for health staff;
- Provision of clean water in under-served areas and upgrade of water and sanitary facilities;

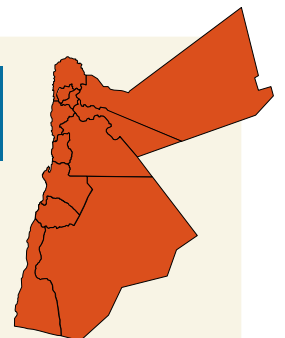

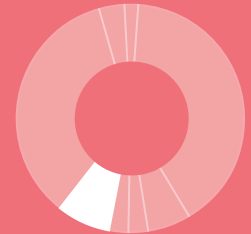
- R1 Syrian refugees are protected according to the IHL principles, including the principle of non-refoulement, facilitation of family reunification and facilitation to maintaining family links;
- R2 Provision of health care to the war wounded and empowerment of local response to emergency preparedness through capacity development;
- R3 Strengthened capacity of the national Red Crescent society to assist refugees and asylum seekers, respond to emergencies and promote respect for people protected by IHL through technical assistance, provision of equipment, and engagement with communities.
