### PROGRAMME SUMMARY

The programme aims to support the education sector in favour of the most vulnerable among the refugee population and host communities in Jordan.

The intervention is part of the priorities indicated by the Jordanian Government in the JRP 2016-2018 and by the Jordan Compact, which the Italian Government has decided to support in the context of funds committed at the London conference in 2016.

The objective of the action consists of contributing to the quality improvement of public services available to the people living in the Country, with particular focus on those who are not able to access basic services due to their financial constraints.

- R1** Improved school access for children in Jordan thanks to improvement of the quality of the school facilities;
- R2** Improved capacities of teaching and non-teaching staff to provide quality education services, which are inclusive and equitable.

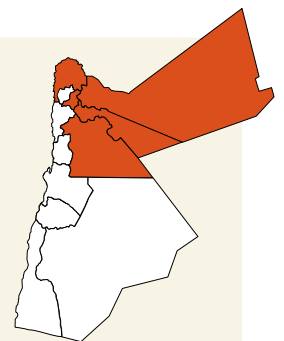

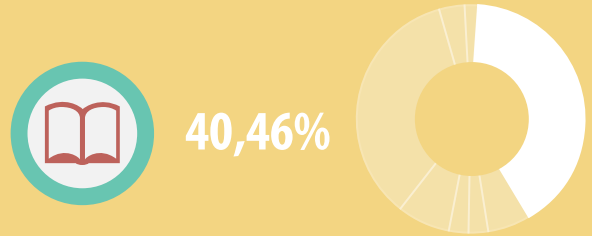
The programme works towards the achievement of the **SDG Objective 4: Ensure inclusive and quality education for all and promote lifelong learning**

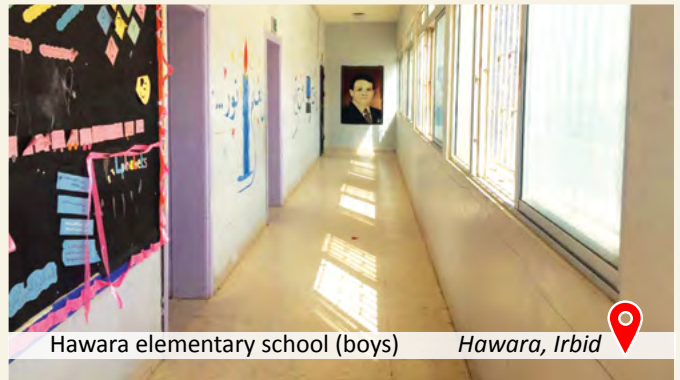
