PROGRAMME SUMMARY

In Jordan, the intervention provided vulnerable children aged 6-17 years and youth aged 18-24 years (including 70% of Syrian refugees) with learning support, psychosocial support, life skills training and other services at UNICEF's *Makani (My Space)* centres throughout the Country.

In Syria, the programme reached 200,000 displaced children and women in hard to reach areas with essential health services, health supplies and immunization services.

R1 **Jordan** – Provided 4,100 vulnerable girls and boys including those out-of-school and at increased risk of child labour, exploitation, early marriage and other forms of abuse with access to educational support and life skills training, with the aim to reintegrate them into the formal school curriculum;

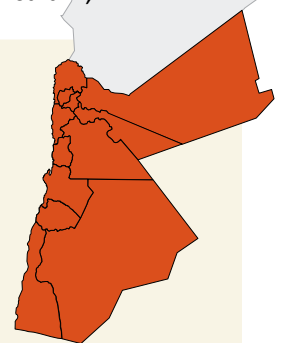

R2 Syria – Operational funds were provided to four local NGO partners running 45 health centres and 49 mobile clinics. Specific results from these funds include 117,000 pediatric and 7,500 maternal health check-ups for highly vulnerable infants, children and IDP women. Lifesaving health services such as pediatric and maternal health care were provided to 242,000 children and 80,500 women.

The project budget was allocated as follow:

- EUR 1.6 million for activities in Jordan
- EUR 0.4 million for activities in Syria.

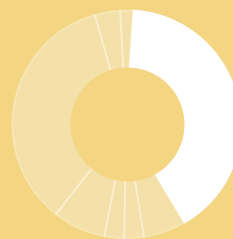


INTERVENTIONS ACROSS THE COUNTRY

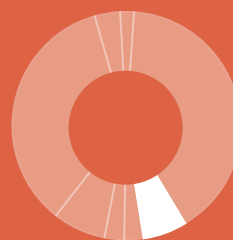
