PROGRAMME SUMMARY

The “*Resilience & Social Cohesion Programme (RSCP)*” programme aims to strengthen the resilience of host communities and Syrian refugees in Lebanon, Jordan and Iraq (Kurdistan), countries that are providing asylum to a large number of refugees and are affected by the protracted conflict in Syria.

In conformity with the National Crisis Response Plans, the RSCP programme works towards developing capacities of national institutions, and strengthening the role of the civil society in delivering medium-long term solutions to the crisis. In line with the EU Madad Trust Fund, the action seeks to ensure the coverage of basic social services delivery, while empowering local communities socially and economically, and decreasing inter and intra-community tensions.

Expected results of the RSCP programme are as follows:

- R1** To provide national and local authorities with effective instruments to perform early recovery and resilience activities;

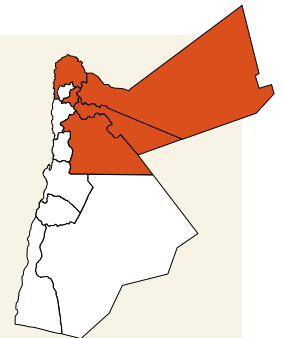

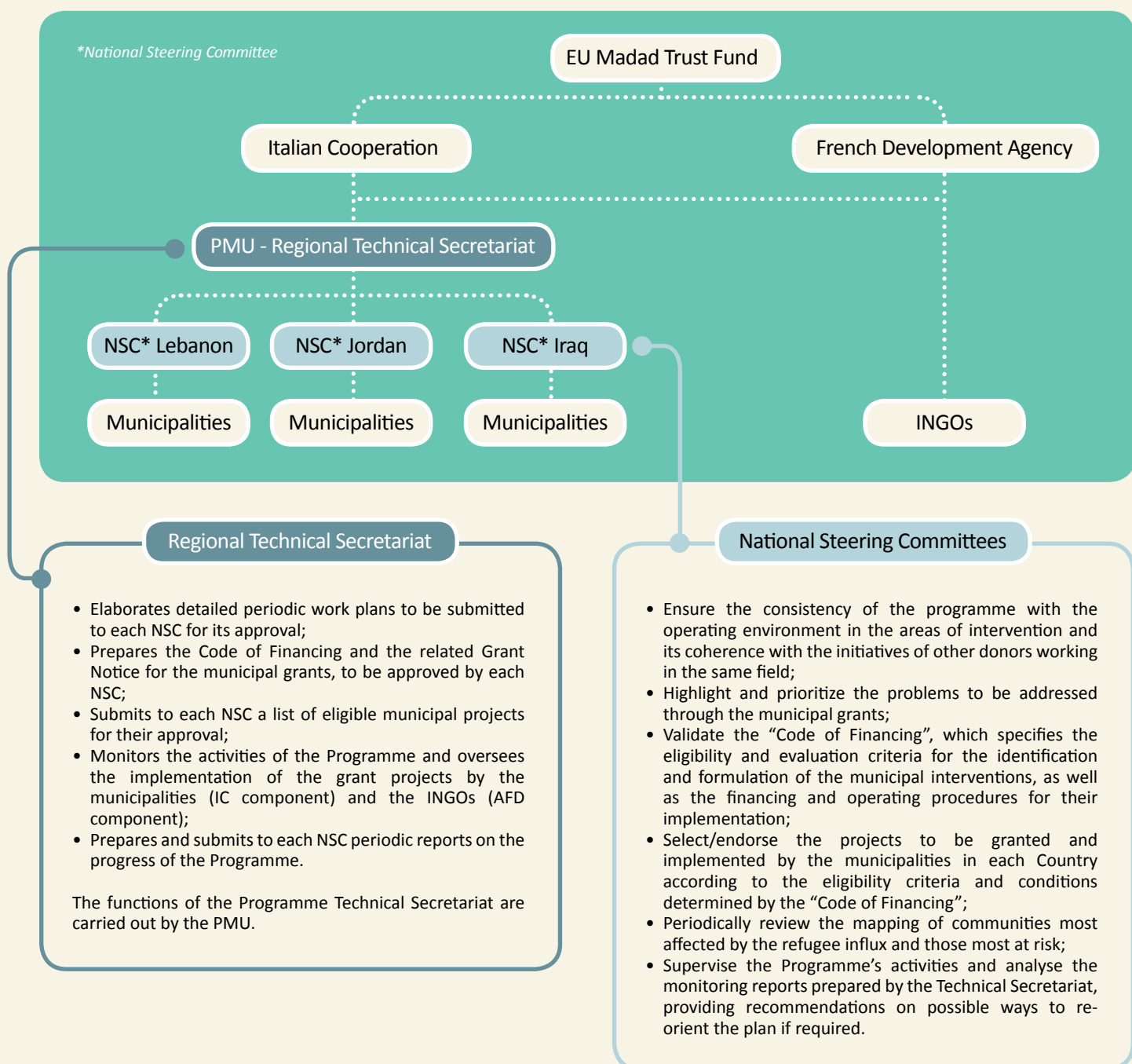

- R4 Reinforced dialogue and resilience of local communities, through the strengthening of the civic and community capacities to promote dialogue and raise awareness on crisis-related matters (AFD);
- R5 Strengthened role of the civil society and of the service-providers in the resilience and stabilisation processes (AFD).
