WHO WE ARE

AICS - the Italian Agency for Cooperation and Development - is one of key innovations established by the Italian law on international cooperation (Law No. 125/2014). The Agency began operating in January 2016, with the aim of aligning Italy with its principal European and global partners in the endeavor of development. Its basic model complies with the demand for more professional and innovative forms of cooperation, involving the methodological flexibility necessary in a continuously evolving scenario.

The Agency is committed to carrying out cooperation initiatives to improve people's living conditions, promote sustainable development, and strengthen democratic institutions and rule of law, as well as sustain post-conflict stabilization.

WHAT WE DO IN JORDAN

AICS in Jordan contributes to the increasing demand for humanitarian and resilience aid, by implementing projects focused on the rehabilitation of basic needs and public services, and refugee response.

Efforts in ensuring prioritization and setting efficient objectives to pursue sustainable and long-term improvement initiatives have been applied consistently, under the umbrella of a participatory approach that enhances the participation of local institutions.



In March 2017, the Italian Government undersigned a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Jordanian Government covering the period 2017-2019. The MoU's aim is to enhance the existing bilateral and development cooperation between Italy and Jordan, as well as to contribute to the achievement of the objectives stated in the programmatic documents issued by the Government of Jordan.



The Italian Agency for Development Cooperation operates in accordance with the Charter of the United Nations, the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, and the Charter of Fundamental Rights of the European Union.

AICS in Jordan implements programmes based on the strategic priorities identified under the MoU, as follow:

- sustainable growth through the efficient use of local resources;
- investing in people and social cohesion;
- governance.




In addition, since the worsening of the Syrian conflict in 2012, the total amount of € 77 million has been granted in support of the refugees fleeing Syria and the most vulnerable Jordanian host communities affected by the pressure of the crisis. In 2020, the Italian Cooperation has allocated around € 13,75 million to assist Italian CSOs and International Agencies on the implementation of projects, in Jordan, in the areas of Education, Health, Infrastructure, Livelihoods, Food security and Protection.




